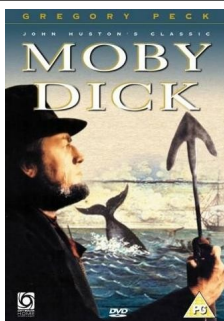

Newcomers are welcome to come to either or both meetings.

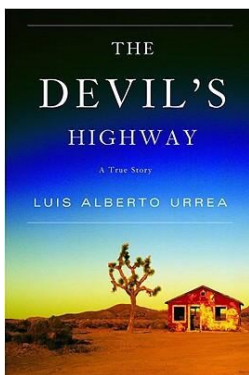

Our Friends group meets on the first Saturday of the month at 10:00 am. If you would like to support the library in fun and creative ways, come and join us!

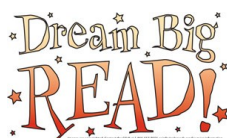


Book Group

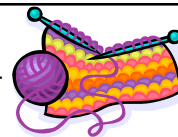


Monday night is MOVIE NIGHT...
